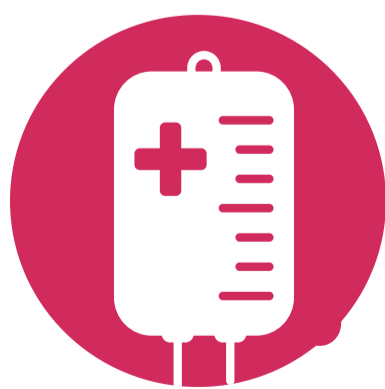

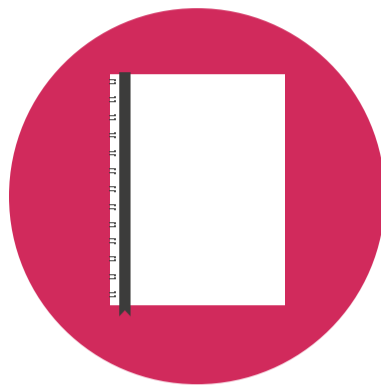
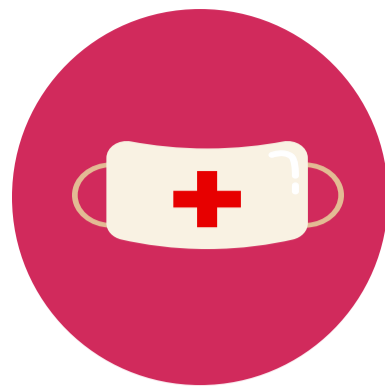
- Participants must be a **registered nurse** who possesses a current unrestricted nursing license to receive verification.
